Required content (*note: make a title slide for each of these sections*)

1. Your top 4 intelligences (in order of dominance), along with at least one picture that represents one of your hobbies (or something that you are interested in) that represents (or connects with) each of these intelligences (one slide each).
2. Your three lower intelligences (in order of dominance), along with a picture that represents something you are doing or plan to do to improve that intelligence (one slide each).
3. Your three learning styles (in order of dominance), along with a picture that represents something you can do to adapt what you are learning to that style (one slide each).
4. Your colors (in order of dominance), along with a picture that represents that color (with that color as the background) (one slide each).
5. Your top five hobbies (one slide each).
6. Your favourite movie with a picture of it and a picture from one of its scenes.
7. One or two of your role models (could be a real person, a movie character, etc.), their picture, and a word that describes why you admire them.
8. Your top 5 goals for this year and a picture that represents each goal (one slide each).
9. If you could be any animal (i.e., in another life let's say), which one would you be? Create a slide with a picture of this animal, and a word that describes why you would want to be this animal.

Required technical elements

1. Each slide must have both a picture/visual and some text (just enough that we can understand the point you are trying to make – keep the words to a minimum – use key words only if possible, or a short phrase).
2. Set it up to play automatically as a slide show with music (i.e., you click *view show* and it plays through the slide show and the song(s)). You can also just play a music file with the slide show, use YouTube to play a song, or hook up an Ipad.
3. Make sure your text is clearly visible against your photos (i.e., choose opposite colors; use “right click – format placeholder” to apply a solid background color when needed).

Note: Your photos and ideas should be unique (i.e., different from everyone else's). Whenever possible, use photos of yourself to make it more about you. You may also use clipart, photos from the internet, etc.
