Instructions for Planning 10 students regarding the Post-Secondary Research Project

- You should now have finished the Career Cruising assignment.
- The *Post-Secondary Project* can be found in our shared folder. Open it up, then save it as your own document in your Home (H) Drive. No need to create a new table; just fill in the information on the table provided.
- A reminder of the few different ways this project can be done. These are your choices:
 - Research two different post-secondary programs at whatever school(s) you are interested in. For example, Sciences at UBC and Forestry at UVIC. Or Arts at Capilano University and Criminology at SFU. Choose this option if you are interested in two different careers.
 - Research the same program at two different schools. For example, Firefighting at the Justice Institute and in Arkansas, U.S.A. Choose this option if you are interested in one particular career.
 - Research an undergraduate program and a graduate program. For example, a
 degree in Sciences, and a Doctorate of Medicine. Choose this option if you are
 interested in one particular career that will require multiple degrees (i.e., Doctor,
 Lawyer, Dentist, etc.).
- Most of the information you will be able to find on the Career Cruising website, while some of it you will need to go to the website of the particular school you are looking into. The Career Cruising website will link you to the many schools in Canada that offer the program needed for various careers. You may also find this site helpful for finding schools that offer the program(s) you are interested in: http://www.educationplanner.ca/
- This site will be useful to help you find current information on labour and market trends (for example, careers that are in high demand): https://www.workbc.ca/
- Some of the information will be difficult to find, but it usually there you just need to look in the right places for it. If you are having trouble finding something, you can ask a classmate for help, or ask your teacher.
